INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

2012 SENIOR CLASS MARSHALS SELECTION PROCESS

- Two Syracuse University rising seniors will be selected as the all-university representatives for commencement activities in 2012. Marshals will lead their entire class into Syracuse University's 158th Commencement ceremonies on May 15, 2012 in the Carrier Dome.
- Only current Syracuse University juniors, graduating in May 2012, who are enrolled in undergraduate programs and will be studying on campus for the entire 2011-2012 academic year are eligible to apply (i.e. not studying abroad).
- Selection criteria will be based upon scholarship, academic honors, student organization involvement, campus service, community service, school spirit, and written essay.
- All applicants must submit a completed application form, signatures from two nominators (SU faculty or staff), a typed essay (maximum 250 words) and transcript.
- Interviews for applicants selected as finalists will take place late February (exact dates TBD).

NOMINATION APPLICATION

- All applicants must print legible responses on the official nomination form.
- Only the official nomination form should be used in responding to questions. Additional pages will NOT be reviewed.
- Applicants must obtain two signatures of nomination AFTER completing the official nomination form. Please note that nominators must be members of Syracuse University's faculty and/or staff.
- Remember to include an official Syracuse University transcript and your essay with your official application form.
- **DEADLINE for application is Tuesday, February 15, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.**
