



## SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY

### **Introduction**

This articulation agreement is developed as a tool for advisement to assist in the transferability of comparable coursework from Georgia Perimeter College to parallel programs of study at Syracuse University.

### **Objectives**

Syracuse University enters into this agreement with the following objectives:

1. To attract qualified community college students into Syracuse University.
2. To facilitate an efficient and smooth transition into Syracuse University from Georgia Perimeter College programs.
3. To provide a path of coursework at Georgia Perimeter College that is applicable to programs of study at Syracuse University.
4. To encourage academic coordination, faculty and administrative interactions, and student engagement.


### **Terms of Agreement**

The establishment of this agreement, the two academic institutions agree to the following terms:

1. Georgia Perimeter College agrees to designate faculty and academic/transfer advisors to facilitate the advisement for students interested in transferring to Syracuse University.
2. Syracuse University agrees to accept the attached list of coursework into the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science programs; provided achievement be no less than a grade of C or better. The maximum number of transferable credit is 66 credit hours.
3. Syracuse University agrees to accept qualified candidates who meet the admissions standards of the desired program of study at the time of admission. Admission to SU is contingent upon a continued record of good citizenship and character. Admissibility into the program of study to be determined by the Undergraduate Admissions Office.
4. The agreement will be subject to annual review by both Georgia Perimeter College and Syracuse University, or in the event there are changes to the curriculum at either institution.
5. Georgia Perimeter College and Syracuse University will recognize and promote the agreement with prospective transfer students.

6. Faculty and administrators at Georgia Perimeter College and Syracuse University will continue to develop collaborative ways to engage prospective transfer students. Please see the GPC Intent to Transfer form, included as an addendum to this agreement for further information.

Georgia Perimeter College and Syracuse University authorize this agreement to become effective July 16th, 2011.

## Articulation Agreement Syracuse University School of Information Studies And Georgia Perimeter College

Syracuse University's School of Information Studies (SU/ iSchool) recognizes that the courses taught at Georgia Perimeter College.

The transfer admission guarantee assures general admission to Syracuse University School of Information Studies (iSchool) for the term listed above. This Intent to Transfer Form must be completed by both student and a GPC TAG counselor.

**Terms of the guarantee:**

1. Apply for admission to Syracuse University iSchool during the application filing period for the semester in which you wish to transfer.
2. Complete the required courses in English composition (two courses) and mathematics (one course) listed below with C grades or better at least two semesters before planning to transfer.
3. Complete an associate degree at GPC including 60 Syracuse University iSchool transferable units and all courses in the required course pattern listed below with C grades or better by the end of the semester preceding transfer.
4. Complete the last 30 of your 60 or more Syracuse University iSchool transferable units at GPC; and
5. Earn a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 in all Syracuse University iSchool transferable course work by the end of the current semester and maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher in all courses taken prior to transfer.

**Required Course Pattern:**

Completion of the core curriculum is required. You must earn a grade of C or better in each course:

**Area A:** English 1101 and English 1102 and one math course from the following: Math 1001 (Quantitative Skills and Reasoning), Math 1111 (College Algebra), Math 1113 (Precalculus) or Math 2431 (Calculus I). Math-based majors are required to take Math 1113 or Math 2431. **NOTE: Only math courses at the level of Math 1113 or higher will transfer to Syracuse University.**

**Area B:** Comm 1201 and 1-3 hours from the following: Prsp 1010 or Rsch 1203 or Foreign Language 1002 or higher.

**Area C:** An English literature course and one humanities elective (Arts 1301 or Arts 1690 or Arts 1692 or Arts 1694 or Film 1010 or Humn 1301 or Humn 1303 or Humn 1305 or Musc 1301 or Musc 1303 or Phil 2010 or Phil 2020 or Phil

2030 or Phil 2040 or Reli 1301 or Thea 1301 or Foreign Language 1002 or higher).

**Area D: Choose 2 of the following:** Astr 1010/1010L or Astr 1020/1020L or Biol 1402/1402L or Biol 1403/1403L or Biol 2107/2107L or Biol 2108/2108L or Chem 1151/ 1151L or Chem 1152/1152L or Chem 1211/ 1211L or Chem 1212/1212L or Envs 1401/1401L or Geol 1121/1121L or Geol 1122/1122L or Phys 1111/ 1111L or Phys 1112/1112L or Phys 2211/2211L or Phys 2212/2212L.  
**Choose 1 of the following:** CSCI 1100 or Math 1113 or Math 1431 or Math 1433 or Math 2431 or Math 2432 or any 3-hour (or 4 hour) science course from the lists in Area D above.

**Area E:** Pols 1101 and either Hist 2111 or Hist 2112 and either Hist 1111 or Hist 1112 and one elective from the following - Anth 1102 or CRJS 1100 or Econ 2105 or Econ 2106 or Econ 2100 or Geog 1101, or Pols 2401 or Psc 1101 or Soci 1101.

**Area F:** Students should follow the Program of Study for General Studies. Eighteen semester hours are required: 3-9 hours from Area C (Humanities, Fine Arts, Foreign Language) and 3-9 hours from Area D (Science, Math, Computer Science) and 3-9 hours from Area E (Social Science). **NOTE: Syracuse University School of Information Studies requires 12 hours of science courses, 9 hours of social science courses, 9 hours of Humanities, and 6 hours of language or quantitative schools as well as 9 hours of general electives in addition to English 1101 and English 1102. Therefore, students should use Area F to fulfill any of these requirements that have not been filled by completing Areas A – E of the Core Curriculum listed above. All students who plan to transfer to Syracuse University School of Information Studies should also have at least one computer science course.**

**Additional Requirements:** Phed 1101 (Choices for Life) and a 1 credit hour activity course or Phed 2006 or Phed 2022.
